

Strategic Government Plan 2025-2029 Transportation Infrastructure

- Railway Project Panama-David-Border: A major initiative to enhance intercity connectivity.
- International Airports: New air logistics terminal, repair and maintenance of runways, and expansion of the Tocumen Airport.
- Regional Airports: Relocation of Domestic Airport in Panama City, and concession of Regional Airports in David, Río Hato, and Colón.
- Cable Car System in San Miguelito: New transportation mode connecting urban regions.
- Panama Metro Developments: Ongoing construction of the metro expansion Line 3, and future routes expansion.

- Fourth Bridge over Panama Canal: Ongoing construction to improve connectivity.
