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Chile-China Phytosanitary Agreement to Boost Fresh-Fruit Exports to China

China's General Administration of Customs and Chile's Ministry of Agriculture signed a fresh-fruit-related memorandum of understanding on August 20, 2026. Chile earned over 2,610 million USD from fresh-fruit shipments to China in 2025. The new deal will simplify phytosanitary checks and lift efficiency for the upcoming southern-hemisphere fruit-export season. **(China Daily official)**

China's Wine Export Value Rises Sharply in First Half of 2026

China's total wine export value surged by 186.79% year-on-year in the January-June period of 2026, reaching 75.10 million USD. Singapore became the top destination for Chinese wine shipments during this period. The strong growth reflects expanding market demand for Chinese-made wine products across overseas markets. **(Wine Business Observer)**

Imported Bottled White Wine to China Hits Nearly 100 Million USD in H1 2026

Major global wine regions delivered double-digit growth of bottled white-wine exports to China during the first six months of 2026, reaching a total value close to 100 million USD. France remained the largest supplier while New Zealand recorded the fastest year-on-year growth rate. Industry analysts forecast further sales growth in the upcoming holiday season. **(Vino joy news)**

China's Imported Spirits Market Shows Obvious Structural Split in H1 2026

China's total imported spirits value reached 803 million USD in the first half of 2026, rising 12.48% year-on-year. Brandy imports saw a strong rebound while vodka and liqueur shipments dropped sharply. Market participants are shifting procurement focus toward high-end spirit products. **(Wine Business Observer)**
