Large-scale logistics drones and delivery systems continue to evolve

Meituan released its 4th-gen drone delivery system (capable of adaptive flight amid heavy rain and force 7 winds) and announced a "15-minute instant delivery" pilot in cities like Shanghai. SF Express's Fengniao Aviation large logistics drone completed its first inter-provincial flight (Shaanxi to Sichuan, covering over 500 km), accelerating remote-area logistics. **(Caillian Press)**

Autonomous trunk logistics is on the eve of large-scale commercial operations

DeepWay, a subsidiary of Baidu, TuSimple, and other companies announced that their L4 intelligent heavy-duty trucks have surpassed one million kilometers in testing on core logistics corridors such as the Beijing-Shanghai Expressway. In October, they secured their first paid freight orders using driverless platooning. **(Sina Finance)**

New round of capacity expansion plans for the Zhengzhou-Luxembourg "Air Silk Road" launched

Zhengzhou Airport's international and regional cargo and mail throughput exceeded last year's full-year volume 2 months early, up 40.6% year-on-year. Cargolux handled 105,200 tons in Zhengzhou in the first nine months of this year, accounting for 22.9% of Zhengzhou Airport's international and regional cargo and mail throughput. Main cross-border e-commerce Temu, Shein TikTok, and AliExpress all settled here. **(Dahe Foutune Cube)**

Green logistics has gone from optional to mandatory

Starting October 1st, several key urban agglomerations (such as the Yangtze River Delta and the Pearl River Delta) officially implemented the "Zero Emission Zone for Logistics and Distribution Vehicles" policy. Simultaneously, the first batch of hydrogen-powered trunk heavy-duty trucks, purchased on a large scale by major express delivery companies, began to be delivered and put into service. **(CCTV News)**
