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Sinopec Launches Key Crude Oil Pipeline In East China To Boost Energy Security

Sinopec has put the 143.8-kilometer Lianyungang-Huai'an crude pipeline section into service, the first 10-million-ton-class crude pipeline for China's 15th Five-Year (2026-2030) Plan. With 18.5-million-ton annual and 70,000-ton daily throughput, it supplies Yangtze-river-belt refineries, optimizes regional energy setup and boosts imported crude allocation and local energy security. **(China Daily)**

First 10-Million-Ton Pipeline Opens New Crude Oil Channel In Yangtze River Delta

The Lianyungang-Huai'an section of a key crude oil pipeline began operations, becoming the first 10-million-ton class pipeline commissioned under China's 15th Five-Year Plan. The 143.8-kilometer section can transport up to 70,000 tons daily. It will connect with the Yizheng hub, optimizing energy allocation for Jiangsu and the Yangtze River region. **(People's Daily)**

Yunnan Accelerates The Construction Of Natural Gas Infrastructure

During Yunnan's 15th Five-Year (2026-2030) Plan, the province speeds up natural gas infrastructure, building cross-province trunks and branches into a "two-horizontal, five-vertical" grid of 4,000 kilometers by 2030 (now 3,549 kilometers, 12 prefectures, 56 counties, 43% coverage). Remote areas use LNG tanks; multi-source supply cuts single-source reliance. **(Yunnan Daily)**

The Unloading Volume Of The Coastal LNG Receiving Terminal Exceeded 10 Million Tons

On Aug 18, CNOOC Jiangsu Binhai LNG terminal passed 10 million tons cumulative throughput after 152 ships since the 2022 startup, latest "Seapeak Marib" 66000 tons. With 10 tanks, 10 million tons of LNG yields 14.2 billion cubic meters of gas, cuts 62.7 million tons of carbon dioxide, equals 130 million trees. Customs cut port time 3 hours per ship, 70% fewer declarations. **(Binhai Daily)**

China's Self-Developed Deep-Water Vessel Haiyang Shiyou 292 Delivered

On August 21, Jiangsu delivered the domestically developed deep-water multipurpose offshore operation vessel "Haiyang Shiyou 292". The vessel has a displacement of 17,600 tons, a range of 15,000 nautical miles, and is pre-equipped with underwater robots and underwater trenching machines, enabling it to perform deep-water marine engineering operations while reducing fuel consumption by 15%. **(CCTV)**
