A single ship carries enough gas to power 6 million households for a month

On February 2, the Spring Festival travel rush began. The "Cosmo Elegance," carrying 66,000 tons of liquefied natural gas (LNG), departed from the Qingdao LNG receiving terminal in Dongjiakou Port after unloading, marking the full commencement of the maritime clean energy transportation support work in North China during the 2026 Spring Festival travel season. **(Qilu Evening News)**

CSSC's Hudong-Zhonghua Shipbuilding Secures Contract for 6 174,000 Cubic Meter LNG Carriers

On January 30, Hudong-Zhonghua Shipbuilding (Group) Co., Ltd., in conjunction with China Shipbuilding Industry Trading Co., Ltd., successfully signed a contract with Malaysian International Shipping Company (MISC) for the construction of the first batch of 3+3 large 174,000 cubic meter liquefied natural gas (LNG) carriers. The charterer for the project is Petronas, the Malaysian national oil company. **(People's Daily Online)**

Changqing Oilfield's natural gas supply to Shaanxi Province increases by 3% year-on-year

At the start of the 2025-2026 heating season, Changqing Oilfield, Shaanxi's top natural gas supplier, optimized production layout to ensure safe and stable supply. Compared with the same period last year, the total amount of natural gas supplied to Shaanxi Province increased by 3%. This greatly alleviated the gas consumption pressure during the heating season and stabilized the energy market. **(Flush Finance)**

Shanghai to Build International Green Fuel "Dual Centers"

Ten ministries and commissions jointly issued a document to support Shanghai's establishment of an international shipping green fuel bunkering and trading center, with the goal of its liquefied natural gas (LNG) bunkering capacity reaching one million cubic meters (liquid) by 2030. The plan also promotes the supply and trading of green methanol and other fuels. **(Sina Finance)**

Tianjin ensure efficient customs clearance of LNG during the Spring Festival

On the morning of February 9, the large Greek LNG (liquefied natural gas) carrier "Leto" docked at the Tianjin LNG receiving terminal of the National Pipeline Network Group. The large LNG carrier "Leto" carried 61,400 tons of LNG, which is about 86 million cubic meters of natural gas, which can meet the gas needs of nearly 6 million households for one month. **(Tianjin Daily)**
